- The College conducted meetings of all the committees and completed the first year of implementation of Autonomy
- Departments initiated 20% change in the syllabus at UG level
- Three new PG programs were started during the Academic Year
- 21-Value-Added Courses, 10- Certificate Courses and 12-Bridge Courses were conducted to bridge the educational gap and skill enhancement.
- The College followed Examination pattern 60:40 (External: Internal) with dual mode- Online and Offline
- At the first Year for the subject of Foundation Course Internals, the Departments initiated a project to convert Green Waste to Compost at the Compost Plant on campus
- Research Committee organised programs to encourage teachers to write research papers in UGC-CARE and Scoups journals
- The required infrastructural changes are being made by the College
- The Mission '*DATE RAHO*' (*BE BOLD*) was initiated to reach out to students, understand their difficulties and provide possible mental and physical support.
- IQAC conducted teachers training programs/ workshops (One Week FDP on 'National Education Policy in Higher Education: Context and Perspectives'. In collaboration with RUSA, Maharashtra and RADAV College (Autonomous) Bhandup)
- For promoting gender equality various programs were conducted. (National Level Conference titled- Women Political Leadership Global to Local – Opportunities & Challenges on 12th January 2022) The initiatives for creating disabled-friendly environment were taken.

Introduction

VPM's K.G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce, Thane is a Higher Education Institute in Thane city well-known for imparting quality education. The quality and progress of the College has been duly measured and assessed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous agency of University Grants Commission (UGC) by awarding 'A' Grades to College in Second and Third Cycles respectively. The College applied for Academic Autonomy to UGC in 2020 and got the Autonomous Status in the same year. The College started execution of Autonomy from the Academic Year 2021-22. The Meetings of the Committees such as Board of Studies (BoS) of respective Departments, Academic Council, Finance Committee, Board of Examination and Evaluation and Governing Body as per the Guidelines of UGC. The changes in the Syllabus were made, new Programs and Add-on Courses were designed. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and College Development Committee (CDC) guided the teaching and non-teaching staff for smooth execution of Autonomy and approved the various proposals from time-to-time.

About the institution

Vidya Prasarak Mandal (VPM)-Thane was founded in the year 1935. Late Dr. V. N. Bedekar, a medical practitioner with an urge to serve the educational needs of the people of Thane started the K.G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce in 1969 under the aegis of VPM, Thane. The approach of VPM is holistic in nature and it strives to provide facilities for intellectual, physical, technical, vocational and cultural education. The ideal of VPM is depicted in its logo 'प्रज्वलितो ज्ञानमयः प्रदिपः' (Let the lamp of knowledge be lighted)

VPM's K.G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce, Autonomous, Thane is the first Higher Education Institute (HEI) established by the VPM. Our college caters to more than 7000 students. The College gives emphasis on personality development of students apart from academics. Besides regular Arts and Commerce faculties, it has spread its wings to many market oriented and Self-financing courses as well as Post-graduate and Add-On courses. The college is a recognized research center for doctoral (Ph.D.) program of University of Mumbai in the subjects of Philosophy, Business Economics (Commerce), and Hindi. Our plethora of alumni consists of eminent personalities in the area of social work, administration, academic, art & literature, healthcare, science & technology, corporate, legal luminaries and banking services. Our sincerity and hard work have been reflected with appreciation like Accreditation of NAAC in Three Cycles and 'a' Grade in Second and Third Cycle, the Best College Award in Urban Zone by University of Mumbai, Best college for Arts and Commerce with Innovation, Research & Academic Excellence in Thane District by Asia Today Research & Media, Most Promising Arts and Commerce College for Holistic Education in Thane District by Asia Today Research & Media. Ours is SWAYAM local chapter to conduct MHRD sponsored free online e-courses designed by eminent professors of IITs and

IIMs under the national Co-Ordinator NPTEL (National Program on Technology Enhanced Learning). We have been granted Autonomous Status by UGC from the academic year 2021-22.

Along with academics we encourage students to participate in Sports, NCC, NSS and DLLE. Our Cultural Festivals such as Chrysalis, *Gandharva* and *Navarang* attract participants from various Colleges from Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) region.

As a part of Institutional Social Responsibility our college has adopted **Takipathar** village in Thane District under NSS scheme. This village is consisting of four hamlets namely Takipathar, Apte, Manikhind, Khardal mostly inhabited by Schedule Tribes. It is under developed, malnourished village with low literacy rate. We conduct various activities like book donations, circulating digital study material, hygiene awareness programs for girl students and other relevant activities as per need from time-to-time

We also undertake social activities such as to impart free coaching to poor students, adopt villages to educate and appraise them about healthcare and government welfare schemes. Most of the activities we involve our students and teachers alike. During Covid-19 pandemic we initiated a mission '**DATE RAHO**' (**BE BOLD**) to reach out to students, understand their difficulties and provide possible mental and physical support.

To sensitize our students to Global socio-economic cultural realities, we have been organizing international tour to Dubai, London & Japan students of Kyoto-Sangyo University visited to VPM's after every 2 years. It has halted due to COVID for last two years.

Keeping in view the holistic development of students, the college has various other committees and academies to stimulate their physical and mental strength. A dedicated Gymkhana and Sports Academy caters to the sportsmen in the students, while committees like Students Forum works for developing their intellectual and literary skills. The counseling cell of the institute ensures support and assures a sound mental health to the students along with a dedicated mentoring system which is in place.

The institute also has some in-house publications like the Monograph, as well as college annual publication titled 'Yuvashilp' and an Annual Newspaper 'ऋत' (Rta). For educational enhancement of students, we design and execute various Bridge Courses, Add-on/Value-Added Courses.

The Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Cell, Placement and Career Advancement Cell and 'Surge', the Alumni Association organize and conduct manifold activities for enhancing the employability of students.

Student centric teaching learning process

The institution caters to the diverse needs of the students through various participative, learning and problem-solving methodologies employed to enhancing learning experiences. In the academic year 2021-2022 due to COVID – 19 Pandemic and prevailing restrictions most of these activities were conducted online.

As first year examinations were declared offline IQAC, Department of Philosophy, Department of Psychology and Counselling Cell jointly organized, Writing Skills Workshop for the students of First Year Degree College of all courses. These workshops were aimed at helping students understand the importance of writing practice and providing them with ways to practice writing in the light of upcoming offline semester end examination. The students were given tasks of 'Writing from Reading' and 'Writing from Memory' in a limited-time format. Total of 898 students participated in the workshops.

Participatory Learning – In addition to regular lectures, Group discussions, projects, quizzes role plays, outreach activities, committees and cell activities, along with seminars and workshops on regular basis are conducted to increase participation and team learning among students. Our own past students are invited to guide present students.

Problem Solving Methodologies – Students solve real life-based simulations, case studies and undertake research and project-based learning along with traditional class room mode of learning. Extra assignments in practical subjects are also undertaken. Movie Screening and Discussions are also undertaken to challenge the critical thinking of students.

Experiential Learning – All the students are groomed to become professionals in their respective field by providing practical learning experiences through live case presentations, peer assisted learning, Research Discussions, Seminars, Internships, book reviews and practical classes apart from the regular traditional mode of teaching and learning

Teachers use ICT enabled tools and E – resources for effective teaching-learning process

Teachers are using ICT enabled tools for effective teaching and learning. The regular use of e-resources enriches the learner and also makes the teaching learning process interesting and interactive.

- During presentations, teachers utilize appropriate links to show live videos of demonstration and procedures.
- Assignments, Projects, Notes etc are shared via Google Classroom and Students are also guided to use online MOOCs, YouTube, Blogs etc
- Students and faculty members utilize e-reference books and journals available in the library. The institute subscribes to on-line databases in order to facilitate students and teachers to access these e-resources.

Vidyanidhi, Open-Gate, DOAR, DOAJ, PubMed, SSRN, PLoS, and COCHRANE
- Digital Repository of Vidya Prasarak Mandal's institutional research publications has been created and is available for access.
- The institution also has its own you tube channel JBC ACADEMICS through which students can watch various academic programmes live as well as later as per their convenience.

Examination and Result

At the backdrop of Autonomous status of the institution the Examination Committee in consultation with Principal, vice Principals and Registrar looks after the planning, conduct, evaluation and timely declaration of results for examinations. It also takes care of settlement of examination grievances, if any, with structured mechanism through Unfair Menace Inquiry Committee.





1. All mandatory committees as per UGC Guidelines are in place.
