## **Autonomy Highlights (Academic Year 2022-2023)**

- The College was conferred an Autonomous Status by UGC on 22-12-2020, for the Academic Year 2022-23 the same was implemented with more rigour and in tune with NEP 2020
- As per the guidelines of UGC College formed various Committees - Board of Studies of all the departments, Academic Council, Finance Committee, Examination and Evaluation and Governing Body
- The College conducted meetings of all the committees and completed the Second year of implementation of Autonomy
- Departments initiated 20% change in the syllabus at SY UG level and PG
- Three new PG program namely MA/F (Masters in Accounting and Finance) was initiated during the Academic Year 2022-2023
- The College continued following Examination pattern 60:40 (External: Internal) with offline mode.
- The required infrastructural changes are being made by the College
- 25 Value-Added Courses/Certificate Courses and 11 Bridge Courses were conducted to bridge the educational gap and skill enhancement.
- To enhance the life skills and employability skills total 20 workshops were conducted
- To enrich teaching learning experience 10 MOU were signed and worked with 07 collaborative partners.
- Towards green initiatives, at the first Year for the subject of Foundation Course Internals, the Department initiated a project to convert Green Waste to Compost at the Compost Plant on campus and for Second Year Foundation Course Plastic Waste Collection Drive was conducted and the same was handed over to Urjaa Foundation and further to Rudra to convert the same into Poly-fuel.
- For B.Voc. Sales and Marketing under Foundation Course Projects students were trained in crafting paper flowers and the same were used in gifting guests at College.
- Research Committee organised Workshop by Dr Girish Kulkarni to encourage teachers to write in SCOPUS Journals
- As an Appreciation to the College efforts of undertaking Participatory Action Project at community level for economic sustenance Zuventus Health Care Limited extended CSR grant of Rs. 27,92,000/- in the phase II, to develop the existing skills with modern

tools. The college would be a catalyst in providing necessary assistance to brand their products, developing an effective Entrepreneurship culture and viable business model.

- In Academic Year 2022-23 Counselling Cell till now guided 113 clients (79 females and 29 males) as per the Consultancy policy.
- The Mission '*DATE RAHO*' (BE BOLD) was continued to reach out to students, understand their difficulties and provide possible mental and physical support.
- IQAC conducted teachers training programs/ workshops on the Writing COs, Mapping and Attainment. As well as workshop for effective teaching methods specifically for newly joined teachers on in collaboration with K. J. Sommiaya Autonomous College of Arts and Commerce
- The initiatives for creating disabled-friendly environment were continued and Cell was named as Atulya Cell. The Cell joined hands with *Samarthanam* Trust to conduct various activities
- First Mentor Meeting between Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Cell of College and Rambhau Mhalagi Prabodhini - Atal Incubation Centre was conducted online on 18-10-2022. The mentors allotted by prabodhini appreciated the work and progress of the students despite being undergraduates and non-technical background and suggested improvements.
- One Day International Conference on Skill Development and Entrepreneurship: Scaling New Horizons was conducted on 21-01-2023 in association with Department of Innovations Incubations and Linkages, University of Mumbai, and collaboration from AIC-RMP, *Garje Marathi* Foundation and AIFMB. As a prelude to the conference the Curtain Raiser was organized on Friday, 20-01-2023 where distinguished speakers, discussed the importance and management of Life Skills. Total 21 research papers were presented during the same. Total No. of received research papers UGC CARE listed Journal 30 and for Peer reviewed Journal 19 from the College. Total Participants - 86
- Under *Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav Har Ghar Tiranga* Campaign was successfully implemented. **Introduction**

VPM's K.G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce, Thane is a Higher Education Institute in Thane city well-known for imparting quality education. The quality and progress of the College has been duly measured and assessed by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous agency of University Grants Commission (UGC) by awarding 'A' Grades to College in Second and Third Cycles respectively. The College applied for Academic Autonomy to UGC in 2020 and got the Autonomous Status in the same year. The College started execution of Autonomy from the Academic Year 2021-22. The Meetings of the Committees such as Board of Studies (BoS) of respective Departments, Academic Council, Finance Committee, Board of Examination and Evaluation and Governing Body as per the Guidelines of UGC. The changes in the Syllabus were made, new Programs and Add-on Courses were designed. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and College Development Committee (CDC) guided the teaching and non-teaching staff for smooth execution of Autonomy and approved the various proposals from time-to-time.

**About the institution**

Vidya Prasarak Mandal (VPM)-Thane was founded in the year 1935. Late Dr. V. N. Bedekar, a medical practitioner with an urge to serve the educational needs of the people of Thane started the K. G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce in 1969 under the aegis of VPM, Thane. The approach of VPM is holistic in nature and it strives to provide facilities for intellectual, physical, technical, vocational and cultural education. VPM's K.G. Joshi College of Arts and N.G. Bedekar College of Commerce, Autonomous, Thane is the first Higher Education Institute (HEI) established by the VPM. Our college caters to more than 7000 students. The College gives emphasis on personality development of students apart from academics. Besides regular Arts and Commerce faculties, it has spread its wings to many market oriented and Self-financing courses as well as Post-graduate and Add-On courses. The college is a recognized research centre for doctoral (Ph.D.) program of University of Mumbai in the subjects of Philosophy, Commerce-Business and Policy Administration Business Economics (Commerce), and Hindi. Our plethora of alumni consists of eminent personalities in the area of social work, administration, academic, art & literature, healthcare, science & technology, corporate, legal luminaries and banking services. Our sincerity and hard work have been reflected with appreciation like Accreditation of NAAC in Three Cycles and 'A' Grade in Second and Third Cycle, the Best College Award in Urban Zone by University of Mumbai, Best college for Arts and Commerce with Innovation, Research & Academic Excellence in Thane District by Asia Today Research & Media, Most Promising Arts and Commerce College for Holistic Education in Thane District by Asia Today Research & Media. - College Magazine Yuvashilp 2021-22 secured first prize in the competition organised in the memory of Shri Raja Rajvade by *Devrukh Shikshan Prasarak Mandals, Ny. Tatyasaheb Athalye Arts & Ved. S. R. Sapre Commerce & Vidhidnya Dadasaheb Pitre Science College, Devrukh, District-Ratnagiri* on 01-02-2023

- Ours is SWAYAM (Study Webs of Active-Learning for Young Aspiring Minds) local chapter to conduct MHRD (Ministry of Human Resource Development) sponsored free online e-courses designed by eminent professors of IITs and IIMs under the national Coordinator NPTEL (National Program on Technology Enhanced Learning).
- Along with academics we encourage students to participate in Sports, NCC, NSS and DLLE. Our Cultural Festivals such as Chrysalis, Gandharva and Navarang attract participants from various Colleges from Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) region.
- As a part of Institutional Social Responsibility our college has adopted Takipathar village in Thane District under NSS scheme. This village is consisting of four hamlets namely Takipathar, Apte, Manikhind, Khardal mostly inhabited by Schedule Tribes. It is under developed, malnourished village with low literacy rate. We conduct various activities like book donations, circulating digital study material, hygiene awareness programs for girl students and other relevant activities as per need from time-to-time
- We also undertake social activities such as to impart free coaching to poor students, adopt villages to educate and appraise them about healthcare and government welfare schemes. Most of the activities we involve our students and teachers alike.
- During Covid-19 pandemic we initiated a mission '*DATE RAHO*' (BE BOLD) to reach out to students, understand their difficulties and provide possible mental and physical support.
- To sensitize our students to Global socio-economic cultural realities, we have been organizing international tour to Dubai, London & Japan students of Kyoto-Sangyo University visited to VPM's after every 2 years. It has halted due to COVID for last two years.
- Keeping in view the holistic development of students, the college has various other committees and academies to stimulate their physical and mental strength. A dedicated Gymkhana and Sports Academy caters to the sportsmen in the students, while committees like Students Forum works for developing their intellectual and literary skills. The counseling cell of the institute ensures support and assures a

sound mental health to the students along with a dedicated mentoring system which is in place.




# External Peer Team Report

The recommendations on the report the progress during autonomy is quite satisfactory. However following suggestions should be taken into consideration.

1. In the case of value added courses, bridge courses and workshops, it is important to mention if certificates were given and the proof of the same. As these courses were of thirty hours or more were the credits given to the students. Also important is the fee structure of these courses. Few courses/ workshops were taken up by less than 10 students. It is necessary to fix a minimum intake limit as well as maximum batch size for any course. Also please mention if all these courses were approved officially by the respective board of studies, academic council and governing body.
2. Under the category internships- it is necessary to mention, how many hours, days, weeks, the internship was offered, and did the students do internship during vacation?
3. The data of students admitted for PG courses is required.
4. Experiential learning through site visit- site visit should be relevant to the subject for which this activity is conducted
5. In case of bridge courses what was the criteria of students for whom the courses were offered. What was the basis of taking up bridge courses?
6. Think of starting new Programmes
7. Promote further use of ICT in teaching-learning
8. Strengthen feedback mechanism
9. Encourage teachers to write more papers and books
